Modern herringbone for a lively aesthetic

The owners of a modern multi-storey townhouse apartment in Amsterdam also got excited about Formpark Quadrato. The European-oak herringbone parquet was laid in the living areas, corridors and kitchen in the apartment, where it easily withstands the challenges of family life. The light, cream-coloured wooden floor stands in pleasant contrast to the black window and door frames, as well as dark modern furniture. With its brushed surface and herringbone pattern, parquet by Bauwerk creates an extraordinarily lively mood and a sense of personal wellness in the apartment.

Bauwerk's innovative stair solution

The stairs—such as those connecting the split levels in the spacious living/dining room—were also made by Bauwerk Parkett in Switzerland. They have the same colour, surface treatment and glossiness as the rest of the parquet floors, thus enabling seamless transitions. Bauwerk also makes use of a unique production method: 'folding' the stair noses without damaging them, producing steps that appear to be made out of one piece of wood.

Swiss precision and quality

Creative laying patterns call for experienced floor installers, such as those at the Dutch company Vloerenhuis, which has been laying parquet for over 100 years, and was hired to install the wooden floors in the Amsterdam apartment. However, the result is only as perfect as the material. 'Laying a herringbone pattern has been and continues to be a discipline of ultimate skill,' says Helmut Valenta, an experienced application technician at Bauwerk Parkett. 'You can't get a proper result without perfect materials. This is why Bauwerk's quality requirements go far beyond the usual standards,' Valenta added. Formpark was developed as a modern 2-layer parquet with a 4-mm European-oak top layer by the Research and Development Centre located at the Bauwerk Parkett headquarters in St. Margrethen, Switzerland. And so, Swiss precision meets Dutch craftsmanship in an Amsterdam apartment.

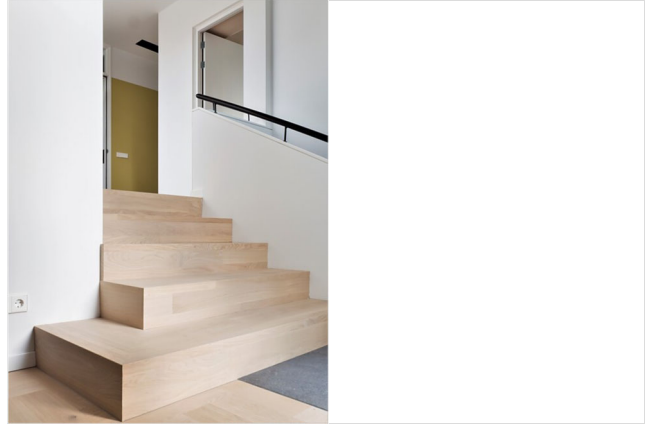
